processing, use curved or "smart" quotes, rather than straight quotes, which indicate inches. Rule #1: Use double quotation marks to enclose a direct quotation (the exact words spoken by someone). DO NOT use quotation marks to enclose an indirect quotation (when the meaning is paraphrased the exact words are not used).
